SHIMUL has successfully completed 20 years and our hostel Shimulchhaya ladies hostel has completed 12 years. Women Empowerment through higher education is our mission. All India NEET has become harder & harder. Special attention, technique, language skills & computer education is required along with knowledge of the academic subjects. Girls from underprivileged background have to overcome the social, economic, psychological and technical hurdles/ barriers.

Shimul Chhaya Ladies Hostel has decided to help at least 10 girls every year to fulfill their dream of higher education and career in medicine. It will be a complete residential-educational package without any cost (food/Lodging/education/electricity, everything will be our responsibility). Through this we aim to extend a kind of social loan or social investment by making these children empowered and capable. When they will be in a stable position, it is expected that they will contribute to the society as well.

Why have we taken this initiative?

Shimul Chhaya is a tribute to my mother Chhaya Roy to salute her long & strong struggle to give me a higher education.

This project Jyotirmaya is a tribute to my father, who was a teacher and to all my teachers who made me an educated person.

Special mention to Kadambini Ganguli, who was the first female graduate and doctor in Asia (1886) and my idol as a Bethune College ex-student,

What is the initiative?

Project Jyotirmaya is about fulfilling the dream to become a doctor and especially a female surgeon. We will support 100 girls to attain MBBS degree from a

government medical college. This year we will start with 10 underprivileged but meritorious girl students.

Why this stage?

There are different types of scholarships & government aids for formal students. But from our experience, we have realized that scope of higher education, becomes harder for those underprivileged girls. This creates a dangerous gap within the society. Society will lose its best merit due to improper planning & implementation of policies.

What will we do?

We have researched thoroughly and identified the gaps, which are as follows and this is where we will extend our support....

1) PROPER LODGING: - Sky may be the limit for our potential but sky as a roof is very dangerous. For some a shelter is a dream. We will give them proper lodging services to ensure their safety and security.

2) ENVIRONMENT: - However, a home with a bad environment will never allow fostering of attention and motivation. We at Shimulchhaya are committed to provide conducive environment that will inspire students to work hard and will also keep them peaceful and free of tension.

3) FOOD: - Balanced diet & timely food habit is also very important for good health & study. We will provide 2 meals, 2 tiffin and 2 tea breaks, which will make them strong and nourished.

4) HEALTH & HYGIENE: - For a young girl hygiene is very important. Proper bathroom habit with sanitary napkin is important for well-being. We will ensure the facilitation of this.

5) EDUCATION & TECHNIQUE: - Even the best of the meritorious students' needs proper guidance & technique for higher education. Study plan with best tuitions & materials will be provided to them to achieve their, as well as our goal.

6) SUPERVISION: - Effective supervision is required for every child specially the underprivileged children who are getting first generation education. Often their parents are incapable of providing the kind of support required and we aim at filling this gap.

7) SAFETY & SECURITY: - Girls who come to the city from very remote areas and humble backgrounds need safety and security. Shimulchhaya is well-equipped to ensure this and also train them in self-defense.

8) CONFIDENCE: - Lack of confidence is a major issue that results in failure. They represent the marginal sections of the society and mostly have low self-esteem. Our counsellor will work continuously to make them confident.

9) COMPETITION: - As this is a high ended competitive exam, it is important to develop competitive spirits. In the hostel they can face tough competition in the mixed environment. Mock tests will be taken regularly to enhance their test-taking skills.

10) TECHNICAL SUPPORT :- In these days, the All India examinations require some high ended technical skills, which again require a technical support - which we will provide. They will get help from our computer training centre.

11) EMPOWERMENT: Social empowerment is required for maintaining dignity. It is important to believe in one-self as well as the society. They will not only be an active member of the society but will also be able to make the world a better place to live in. One man had asked me - What is your benefit? I told him with a smile, that this is not my benefit, this is the benefit of society & you are also a part of that. After 10-15 years you may need a proper operation and this girl will give you back life. If you do something- they you can at least expect change but if you sit idle you will never be able to amend and improve. My grandmother always asked her followers- How many seeds have you planted today that you are expecting fruits tomorrow. So my job is to plant a seed - nurturing the saplings, to handover the baton to my next generation, to say that - yes there is faith, there is love & the world is very beautiful.

Budget: - Budget of this project is Rs. 15 Lakh.

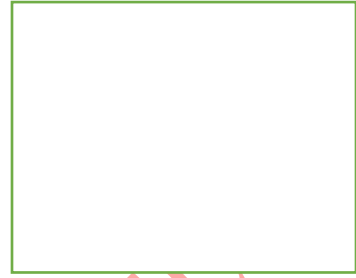
